## **Join us for the November Annual Training Day, Wednesday November 15, 2023**

PIRCOD is partnering with Prison Ministries of Delaware to increase the number of volunteer mentors in the State of Delaware.

This training workshop will feature Prison Ministries of Delaware Mentorship Program, facilitated by Pastor Joyce Warrington of Dover Miracle Revival Center. The primary objective of this workshop is to highlight the importance of mentoring, provide an overview of mentorship training and demonstrate how mentoring can support individuals and families navigating the criminal justice system. It is a workshop for anyone interested in investing into the life of someone impacted by the criminal justice system (peer support specialist, ministry outreach workers, community engagement specialist, social workers, family support workers, reentry service providers, youth program staff, direct care and/or faith-based program administrators and others who interact or provide services related to incarceration).

The Prison Ministries of Delaware Mentorship Program has been reviewed by the Delaware Department of Correction (DOC) and determined to be in alignment with DOC security procedures. In addition to addressing DOC operational standards the curriculum provides practical guidance on how to engage others in discussion and provides support related to the individual's emotional and spiritual development during and after incarceration.
